- Participate in the <u>OTT Conference</u>.

In addition, participating think tanks benefit from:

- Ongoing mentoring and advice from the On Think Tanks team,
- Access to the global OTT community of think tanks and evidence informed policy experts,
- Access to capacity building resources and opportunities, and
- A platform and channels to share their work globally.

With funding from the Open Society Foundations, OTT currently offers support to student-led think tanks across Europe.

The opportunity

OTT Consulting is widening the reach of the <u>Building for the Future</u> initiative by opening it to more think tanks and think tanks in other regions.

Student-led think tanks are organisations established and operated by students, often within a university, that engage in research, analysis, and advocacy on various public policy or social issues.

These think tanks aim to emulate and innovate on the structures and functions of established think tanks while providing students with opportunities to develop research, policy analysis, and leadership skills.

Participants gain hands-on experience producing policy briefs, organising events, and engaging in advocacy efforts. These think tanks also create opportunities for networking with academics, policymakers, and experts, expanding students' career prospects and connections.

By amplifying student voices on important social and policy issues, they encourage civic engagement and contribute to shaping informed public discourse, allowing young leaders to make a meaningful impact on their communities and beyond.
